

Date	Theme	Brief
20th February	Something old	Anything old but not necessarily decrepit. AR and Composites allowed. Examples old wedding dress, baptism dress, mechano set, cameras out of posterity, antique motor vehicles, vintage planes the objects are endless.
20th March	All wrapped up	Look around and find something different that is wrapped up. AR and Composites allowed. Examples - bark on a tree, a cocoon, a banana in its peel. Consider using a shallow depth of field.
10th April	Transport	Any mode of transport may be the subject of this theme. No AR or Composites allowed. Ideas out of the box include wheelchair, hot air balloon, hang glider, donkey car, baby carriage and many, many more.
15th May	Birds eye view	Look at something straight from above. AR and Composites allowed. Try and take the photo as square on as possible - with our camera parallel to the ground.
12th June	Negative space	A key element of artistic composition. It's the space around and between the subject of an image. It may be most evident when the space around a subject, not the subject itself, forms an interesting or artistically relevant shape. No AR or Composites allowed.
17th July	Big skies	The sky must be the hero in your photo. Remember "The Rule of Thirds". Make the top two thirds the sky and the bottom third the foreground. Keep the horizon straight. No AR or composites allowed.
14th August	Black and white	This is mainly about tone and texture. Perhaps think about using either high or low key black and white. AR and Composites allowed.
18th September	Smoke or steam	Photograph smoke (from a braai, a cigarette etc) or steam (from a kettle, an iron etc). You will probably need to use a dark background and fiddle with the angle of your light source to enhance the effect. Then convert your image to black and white. AR and composites allowed.
18th October	Hands	Old hands, young hands, hands holding hands, hands clasped in prayer, hands squashing oranges, hands kneading dough, hands pointing the way, not only human hands, monkey hands, chameleon "hands" as long as they can grasp things they are "hands". No AR or Composites allowed.
13th November	Night	Photograph a night scene either indoors or outside. You may want to use a tripod and switch to manual focus if you are struggling to focus. No AR or Composites allowed.
15th Jan2023	A flame or flames	A roaring braai fire, the simplicity of a candle flame, a lit match....You will probably need a dark background to show off its beauty - perhaps underexpose a bit to enhance the colour. You could include a prop and create a photograph with a mood in order to tell story. AR and Composites allowed.
