Brief for Silence/Serenity:

- Photos submitted must prompt the emotion/story of peace/serenity/silence.
- One image, HDR accepted, standard post production allowed & encouraged.



- Serenity calm & peaceful
- The Photograph can contain an image depicting the feeling of SILENCE and or SERENITY
- Go to a place where you feel silence and serenity
- Each person has there own definition and place of silence and serenity
- Be emotionally drawn to an Image
- Step back and connect with the emotion of the experience.
- Allow the emotion of a subject to brew before the logical side of an image kicks in.
- Capture just enough to convey the (story and) emotion.
- You may have a passion about something that's already established ...
- Try get the feeling then look at the technical aspects
- Then Invite the viewer to try feel and experience the same
- Freeze the moment ... savour it, to pause and absorb it (photography)
- Remember the name.
